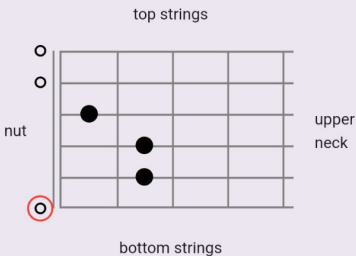
Here's a few quick tips

SHAPES

Strings are horizontal lines.
Frets are vertical lines.

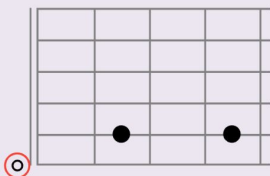


Example: open E chord



RIFF AND LICK SHAPES

These are like scale shapes, not chord shapes. Many times you're not playing the notes simultaneously, like you would with a chord.



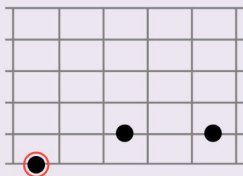
Example: open E riff

The two notes on the fifth string can't be played at the same time.



PLAYING SHAPES

Each shape just shows you where to put your fingers. It won't tell you exactly how to play it. That may be different from one song to the next.



this song	5th fret
that song	8th fret

Example: moveable riff shape

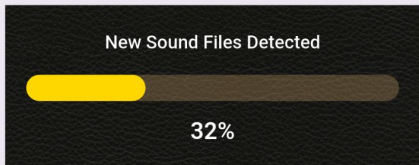
The two songs use this same shape, but at different places on the neck





SHAPE UPDATES

Sometimes shapes will be updated. You won't need to do anything; they'll load automatically.



If sounds are updated, you'll see a loading screen. It should take no more than a minute.
